Contractor Safety Manual: Is designed to provide all contractors, including inspectors, sub-contractors and contract employees with Kinder Morgan's contractor expectations and essential Environmental, Health & Safety (EHS) information required to successfully complete tasks while working at Kinder Morgan facilities.

Contractor Safety Evaluation Database: The ISNetworld database allows Kinder Morgan to evaluate/select a contractor who has met the requirements for the contractor safety program. It provides data evaluation of each contractor's supplied information. The database has three key elements:

- MSQ Questionnaire Results
- Automatic EHS Evaluation/Ranking
- Allows any Kinder Morgan hiring manager access to the Contractor's supplied information and data.

Contractor Safety Orientation: Before a contractor starts any job they must receive a general and a site specific safety orientation at least once a year. This can be accomplished by reviewing:

- The Contractor Safety Manual
- The Contractor DVD
- Business Unit or Site Specific Safety requirements.

Verification of general and site specific safety orientation shall be in the form of:

- CSM-003 "Contractor Pre-Job Safety Orientation Report" (NOTE: Maintain records on-site or in project records).

This program helps KM evaluate our contractor's safety performance and reflects KM's safety requirements and programs in a manner that are consistent with KM's expectations for its own assets and employees. - ✓ **Liability Protection**

Who needs to participate in the Kinder Morgan Contractor Safety Program?

All contractors who perform work at our facilities are required to participate in the core components of the program.

What are the general Kinder Morgan Contractor Safety requirements?

Contractor safety program elements include:

- Current & Valid Contract
- Current & Valid Insurance Requirements
- Drug & Alcohol compliance
- Approved DOT Operator Qualification, when applicable
- Safety History Verification
- Safety Programs Verification
- Safety Training Verification
